



Thanks for helping *Keep Oconee Open* and our community safe!


Thanks to our supportive community, Oconee County Schools has now been opened for 115 days for in-person instruction. As of last Friday, 98.74% of inperson students and staff were not actively diagnosed with COVID-19 or quarantined as a result of being a close contact.

"Working in partnership with our families, students, and staff, we continue to have a safe and successful school year," said Superintendent Jason L. Branch. "We are so appreciative of the support of our entire school community in helping us mitigate the spread of COVID-19 and look forward to the rest of the second semester."
