No-Cost Breakfast and Lunch through December

All Oconee County students now receive breakfast and lunch at no cost through the end of this semester. This change began Sept. 10, 2020 and will be in effect through Dec. 31, 2020 or as federal funding provides. As announced by U.S. Secretary of Agriculture Sonny Perdue, this flexibility is being provided as the country recovers

from the COVID-19 pandemic. OCS is eligible because the system provided meals at no charge to families from March-July 2020 through the USDA Seamless Summer Program.
