Warrior Students and Parents,

Taking Advanced Placement exams is a critical component of all Advanced Placement courses. Oconee County High School requires that all students take the Advanced Placement exam for any Advanced Placement course they are enrolled in. Scoring well on an Advanced Placement exam can often earn students college credit for their high school class, saving a significant amount on tuition.

For the May 2021 Advanced Placement exams, students at Oconee County High School will be registering online. Online exam registration will begin on Monday, August 31, 2020 at 8:00 AM and end on Friday, November 6, 2020 at 4:00 PM. The Advanced Placement exam registration process is a two-step process and both steps can be completed in one sitting with the student and parent/guardian working together. Both steps must be completed in order to ensure the correct Advanced Placement exams are ordered.

Step 1: Begin the process by registering at www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/113190. Here you will indicate which Advanced Placement courses you are taking this year and which Advanced Placement exams you will need to order. Any exam fees will be paid online so be sure to have a **debit card or credit card available before beginning registration**. Paying online is a great way to make sure that payment has been made while avoiding mailing payment. If needed, a mailing payment option is provided.

Step 2: Students will then create a College Board account if they have not already done so at <https://www.collegeboard.org/>. They will then use the join codes provided at the completion of step one through *Total Registration* to enroll in their Advanced Placement courses directly with the College Board. Students taking Advanced Placement courses through GA Virtual School during the Fall 2020 Semester should be entering join codes for the appropriate GA Virtual School class. *Special Note: If students are transferring to an Advanced Placement course with Oconee County High School from GA Virtual School in January 2021, there will be a transfer code provided then that they can use to join the Oconee County High School Advanced Placement course.*

This year each Advanced Placement exam costs \$98.00. Students requiring financial assistance should contact Mrs. Kim Harmelink, kharmelink@oconeeschools.org, at Oconee County High School for more information.

Below are the important dates for the registration process. These dates apply to **BOTH** Fall and Spring Semester Advanced Placement courses.

- **Monday, August 31, 2020 at 8:00 AM - Registration Begins**
- **Friday, November 6, 2020 at 4:00 PM - Registration Ends**
- **Monday, November 9, 2020 - Registrations that have not been paid for will be cancelled and exams will not be ordered.**
- **Friday, November 6, 2020 - Last day to cancel an exam and receive a full refund.**
