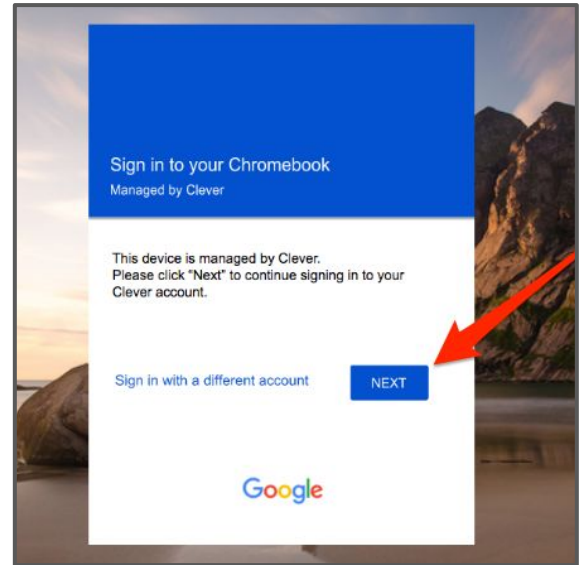


What are Clever Badges?

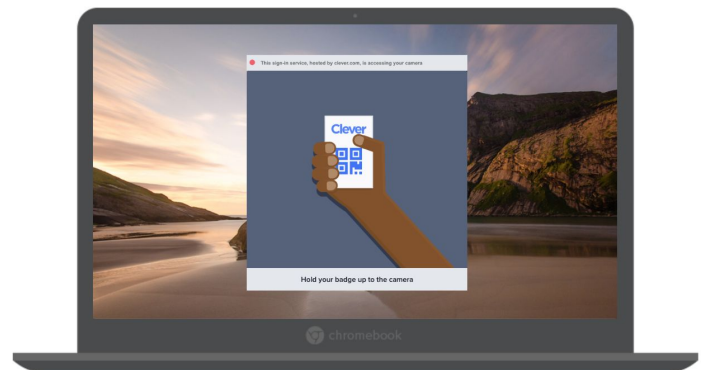
Clever Badges are only available for K-2 students at this time. Badges are perfect for students who have trouble typing or remembering complex passwords - especially younger learners. Badges allow students to hold up a physical badge to their device's webcam to get logged in, instead of typing in usernames and passwords. Badges provide direct access to a student's Clever account and should be protected just like a password. Anyone who has access to a Badge can sign in as the student and access their accounts in both Clever and connected applications. Please protect the security of your students and do not share images of the QR code publicly on social media.

How do Clever Badges work?

1. Students turn on the chromebook. They will have the option to choose "Sign in with a different account" or the blue "NEXT" button. They should select "NEXT".
2. Once they select the "NEXT" button, the badge screen will appear.
3. They should then be able to scan their badge, see a green checkmark.
4. Once students see the green checkmark, the Clever loading page will appear and the student will be signed into the Chromebook!

No Badge? Login with Students Google Account

If your student is not using a Clever Badge, they can still log into their Chromebooks by typing in their Google email address and password. Students should experience the following login flow when they want to login with Google:

1. They will have the option to choose "Sign in with a different account" or the blue "NEXT" button. They should select "Sign in with a different account".
2. Once they select the "Sign in with a different account", they will be prompted by Google to enter their Google email and password.
3. Once they enter their credentials and hit "NEXT", they are signed into their Chromebooks!
