North Oconee High School was established in 2004 as a public, rural, comprehensive high school. It is one of two public high schools in the Oconee County School District. North is accredited by AdvancED for the Southern Association of Colleges and School Council on Accreditation and School Improvement (SACS CASI), the North Central Association Commission on Accreditation and School Improvement (NCA CASI), and the Northwest Accreditation Commission (NWAC). It is a member institution of College Board, National Association of College Admission Counseling, and Southern Association of College Admission Counseling.

CURRICULUM & GRADE REPORTING

SCHEDULE

School year includes:

- Two 18-week semesters (4X4 Hybrid Block)
- Four 90-minute periods and one 25-minute homeroom/enrichment period each day.

- Grade-level courses meet daily. Most Advanced Placement and support-level courses meet every other day for the entire academic year.
- All students must take four courses per semester.

GRADING SYSTEM & GPA CALCULATION

A = 90 - 100 B = 80 - 89
C = 70 - 79 F = 69 & BELOW

AP and Dual Enrollment classes are awarded a 10% weight and Honors/accelerated classes are awarded a 5% weight when calculating the "Weighted GPA." No additional points are added to the final averages that appear on transcripts for AP, Dual Enrollment, or Honors classes.

Beginning with the Graduating Class of 2023, the Oconee County School District has discontinued the use of class rank with the exception of honoring the top three graduates.



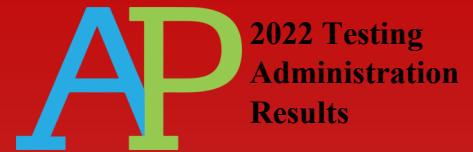

*Due in large part to the limited access to testing sites that were reduced in seating capacity or closed altogether in response to COVID-19, the University System of Georgia waived SAT and/or ACT score requirements for admission. Consequently a significant number of students in the class of 2022 applying to its member institutions did not test.
